

Senate Floor Action for March 1, 2018

Bills that passed the Senate

Marijuana Referendum (SB 2275): Creates a statewide advisory public question to be submitted to the general public on Nov. 6, 2018, asking if the voter supports legalization, possession, taxation, and regulation of marijuana. The vote will be a simple “yes” or “no.” The exact language of referendum: “Do you support the legalization of possession and use of marijuana by persons who are at least 21 years of age, subject to regulation and taxation that is similar to the regulation and taxation of tobacco and alcohol?”
